

**PETITION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA**

**WE, the undersigned, citizens of Canada, draw the attention of the Government of Canada to the following:**

THAT every year, hundreds of thousands of dogs and cats are brutally slaughtered for their fur in a number of Asian regions. The animals live in deplorable conditions—they are kept cold for thicker coats, kept weak for slaughter and are crowded into small crates and bags for transport. At the end of their lives, they are slaughtered for their pelts.

Canada should join the USA, Australia, and the European Union in banning the import and sale of dog and cat fur. We are the only developed country without such a ban. Furthermore, it should be mandatory that all fur products being imported or sold in Canada have labeling identifying the species of origin.

**THEREFORE, your petitioners call upon the Government of Canada to:**

**Introduce AND support government legislation to amend the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act and the Textile Labelling Act based on Bill C-296 from the 41<sup>th</sup> Parliament.**
